MANOR CROFT ACADEMY PHYSICAL EDUCATION – SCHOOL TEAMS

Physical Education is a compulsory subject on the school curriculum and all students are expected to participate unless there are extenuating circumstances. Participation in PE/Sport brings many benefits in terms of a student's physical well-being. Therefore, all students are expected to bring the appropriate PE kit to every lesson. If a student forgets their kit they will not be allowed to go home to collect it and there will be a sanction imposed.

If a student has a medical issue, that would prevent normal participation in physical activities, then parents should provide either a written note or a note in the student's planner, outlining the reason for non-participation.

However, students will still be expected to participate in the lesson in another appropriate way, such as umpiring, assisting with equipment, peer assessing other students, scoring matches. Therefore, students who bring a note should also bring their PE kit. This will also make sure that their school uniform is not soiled when they are taking their part in the lesson.

Students are encouraged to take part in school teams for various sports. Please provide your consent on the My Child At School App if you agree to your child taking part in sports fixtures. Details of specific dates and times will be sent to you as appropriate.

By giving consent on the app you are acknowledging the following:

- I understand the risks associated with competitive sport
- I understand that my child will be transported to away fixtures in approved vehicles
- I understand that fixtures can sometimes be organised at very short notice
- I understand that my child's behaviour when representing Manor Croft Academy should adhere to Academy expectations
